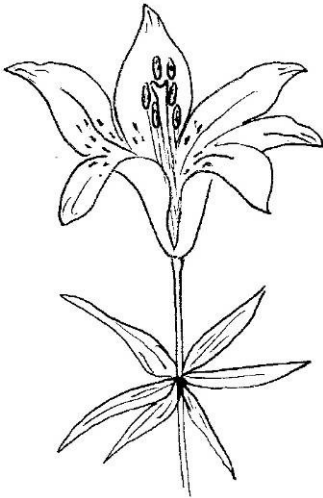


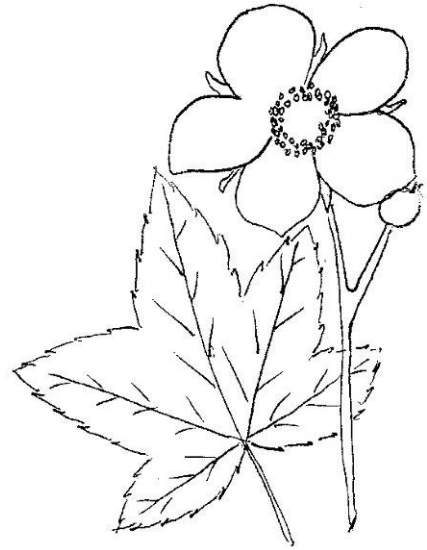
## FLOWER FAMILIES



### Lily Family

3 sepals  
3 petals  
petals & sepals same size and color  
6 stamens (some may lack anthers),  
3-parted pistil

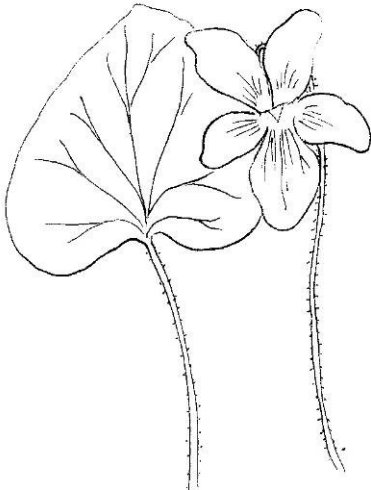
Examples: Lily, Tulip, Hyacinth,  
Daffodil, Trillium, Lily of the Valley



### Rose Family

5 sepals  
5 petals  
many stamens (usually multiples of 5)  
usually several pistils (5 in Apples)

Examples: Rose, Apple, Strawberry,  
Raspberry, Cherry, Plum



### Violet Family:

5 sepals  
5 petals (bottom petal longest)  
5 stamens  
1 pistil with thickened head and short  
beak

Examples: Violet, Pansy, Johnny-  
Jump-Ups



### Aster Family

Flowers in heads made up of many  
smaller flowers growing together on a  
disk, each producing one seed.

Each tiny flower has:

5 petals fused into a tube,  
5 stamens fused together into a tube  
around the pistil,  
1 pistil with two stigmas.

Examples: Daisy, Aster, Dandelion,  
Sunflower, Goldenrod
